

Cloudflare Domain Migration Checklist

Prepare Old Account

- ☐ Export DNS records - Cloudflare Dashboard → DNS → Export (CSV or BIND format)
 - ☐ Document Page Rules
 - ☐ Document Firewall Rules
 - ☐ Document Workers
 - ☐ Document SSL/TLS Settings
 - ☐ Document Caching & Performance Settings
 - ☐ Document Rate Limiting
 - ☐ Document Email Routing (if used)
 - ☐ Disable DNSSEC - DNS → DNSSEC → Disable

Migration the New Account (this step is the same regardless of where you are migrating from)

- ☐ Add domain to new Cloudflare account
- ☐ Use identical DNS records during setup.
- ☐ Update nameservers at domain registrar

- ☐ Set to the nameservers provided by the new account.
 - ☐ Wait for DNS propagation - Check with tools like dig, whatsmydns.net, or nslookup.

Post-Migration Cleanup

- ☐ Verify domain is “Active” in new account
- ☐ Add Back Page Rules
- ☐ Add Back Firewall Rules
- ☐ Add Back Workers
- ☐ Caching, SSL, Rate Limits, etc.
- ☐ Re-enable DNSSEC (if previously used)
- ☐ Delete domain from old Cloudflare account
